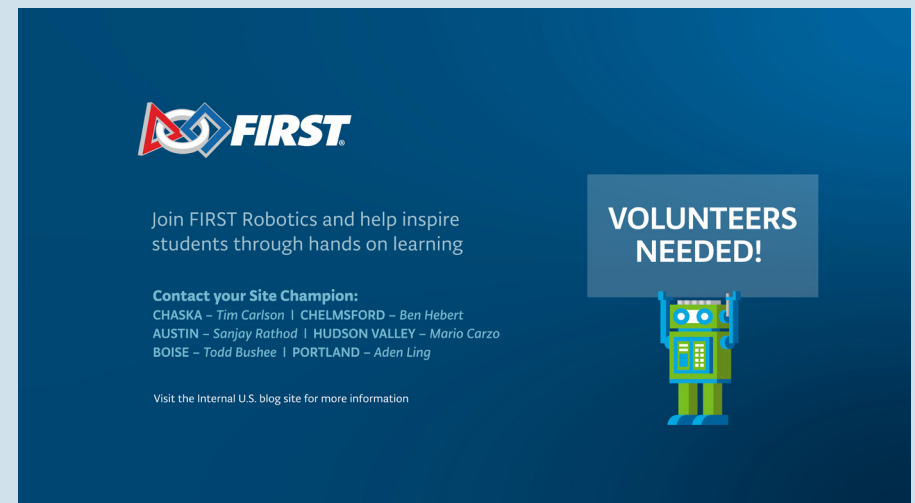
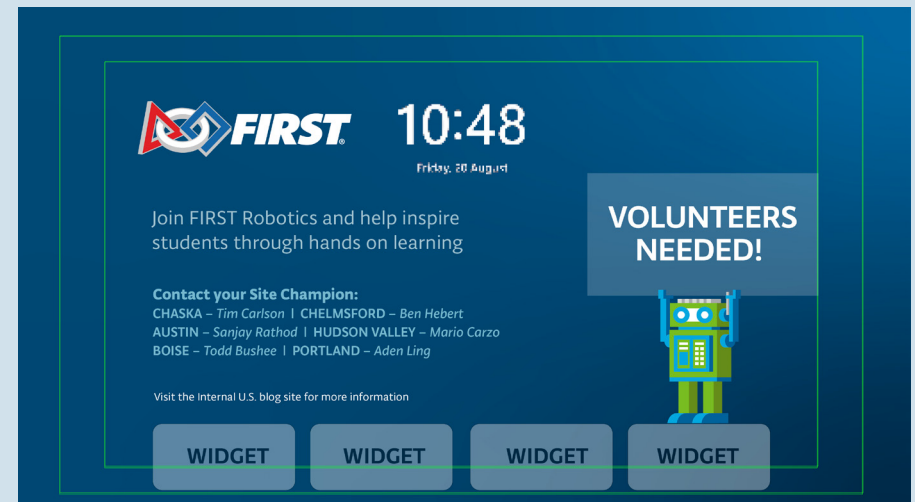


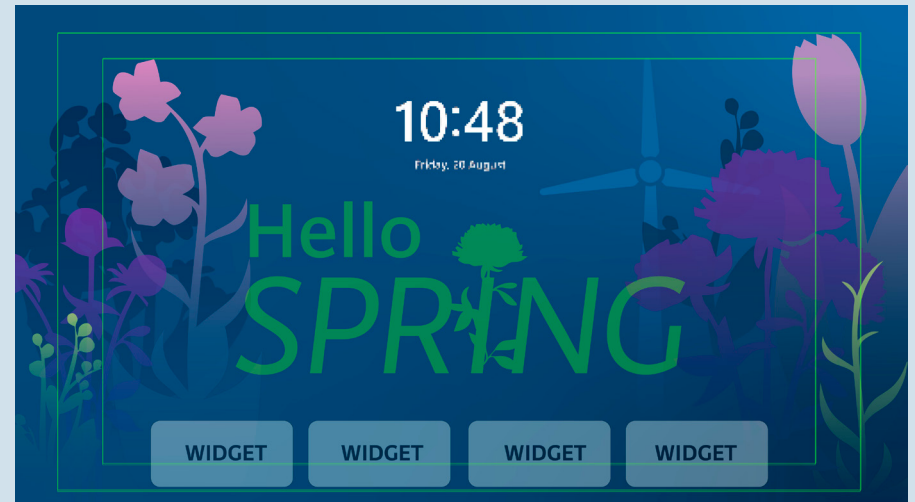
Computer Lockscreens

I designed informative lock screens to communicate important announcements, seasonal messaging, and event information across Window computers. Each design had to follow established brand guidelines while accounting for the computer screen's cropping boundaries and reserved space for desktop widgets. This required careful consideration of layout, hierarchy, and placement to ensure key information remained clear and visible across the screen configurations.

This seasonal lock screen provided more creative flexibility, allowing me to explore a more impressive visual direction while still maintaining consistency with the company's established guidelines. Another example of seasonal lockscreens that maintained brand consistency within the screen guides.



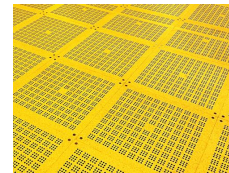
Informative Lockscreen

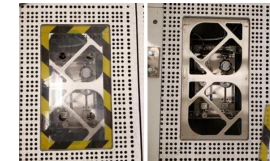
Floor Tile Policy

Internal Use Only

- Grated/Perforated Tile: TEL personnel are **not allowed** to open, remove, or move perforated/grated floor tiles at **customer sites**. Coordinate with the customer.



- Clear View Tiles: TEL personnel are **allowed** to open clear view tiles at **customer sites**. The view tile must have a non-removable metal frame installed. The cover must be replaced after completion or if personnel leave the area.
